POLICY FOR TRAVEL AND TOURNAMENT ASSISTANCE

Travel Policy

Coaches, parents, and participants are reminded that they are ambassadors to our community and should act accordingly.

If coaches are of the opposite gender to players on the team they are coaching, a chaperone of the same gender as the players must be on the bench and travel with the team out of town as well as overnight trips.

All coaches/managers must also complete our risk management documents and have a criminal record check and a drivers abstract.

Travel Assistance

Each Development Team wishing to participate in soccer tournaments can apply to CRYSA for up to \$200.00 per season (Fall and Spring). Monies can only be used for BC Soccer sanctioned tournament fees or tournament registration fees and must be supported by receipts.

Each U8 to U11 Team (Keeners Program) wishing to participate in soccer tournaments, can apply to CRYSA for up to \$300.00 per year. Monies can only be used for BC Soccer sanctioned tournament fees or tournament registration fees and must be supported by receipts.

Each U12 to U18 Team (playing within the UISA Development League) wishing to participate in soccer tournaments, can apply to CRYSA for up to \$600.00 per year. Monies can only be used for BC Soccer tournament fees or tournament registration fees and must be supported by receipts.

Each U12 to U18 Team (playing within the UISA Development League) can apply to CRYSA for up to \$500.00 per year to assist with travel costs associated with Cup play (Island, Coastal or Provincial) and if travelling off Vancouver Island or to Powell River. Costs must be supported by receipts.

Each U12 to U18 Team (playing within the UISA Development League) can apply to CRYSA for additional funding to assist with travelling expenses associated with Provincial finals if travelling off Vancouver Island.

VIPL players registered with CRYSA can apply to CRYSA for funding to assist with travelling expenses associated with Cup play or Provincials (as above), on a proportional basis based on the number of CRYSA players on the VIPL team.

All the above funding is subject to the discretion of the CRYSA Directors.
